

Brief Description of the Assignment	The Health Economics Unit (HEU) is the designated focal point of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare for tracking health expenditures in Bangladesh and has so far completed 06 rounds of the Bangladesh National Health Accounts (BNHA) for the period 1997 to 2020. HEU envisages the development of the 07th round of BNHA for 1997-2023. It is planned to estimate the expenditure primarily using the System of Health Accounts (SHA) 2011 compatible BNHA framework for 2020-2023 (based on the availability of audited expenditure data from IBAS++).
